Keep your ears dry for 24 hrs post the procedure

There is a small risk of infection following Microsuction. Be aware of the following:

- Any redness or inflammation to the outer part of your ear (the Pinna)
- Any pain, discharge or excessive itching or odour.
- If you become unwell or develop a temperature.
- If you suffer with any of the above please contact your GP or contact the NHS 111 service.

If you have had microsuction for because you were having hearing difficulties, and this does not improve after the procedure, you should seek further medical advice from your GP as excessive wax is not the only cause of hearing loss.

Microsuction may trigger symptoms of Tinnitus but this should settle within a few days. If symptoms persist then seek advice from your GP.

REMEMBER: Never insert cotton buds into the ear canal
